Internet data abnormality management regulation

2008.7.30. Passed by the Security Committee

- I. To manage network data usage effectively in National Taiwan University (NTU), National Taiwan University Computer and Information Networking Center (C&INC) specially set the Internet Data Abnormality Management Regulation.
- II. C&INC constructed “Campus Internet Management System” to rank data that goes in and out of the campus IP and announce it on the C&INC website.
- III. Per IP of the dormitory internet is 6GB per day total (upload and download). Transmission speed will decrease to 256Kbps if exceeded.
- IV. For teaching or research purposes, and approved by the department or supervisor, mass internet transmission or P2P application is available to apply through the C&INC.
- V. When the “Campus Internet Management System” detects data abnormality, violated computer will be restricted from internet usage. Violation handling process as followed:
 1. Restrict violated computer to connect to the internet and announce the violation reason on NTU information security service group website.
 2. Notice the department unit or dormitory internet manager through email for assistance.
 3. After confirming problem solved according to the response from the user to the internet manager, C&INC will relieve the restriction to this computer.
 4. Serious violations will be handed over to the department or supervisor for further treatment.
- VI. When passed by the C&INC security committee, will implement on release date.
