

**NATIONAL TAIWAN UNIVERSITY**  
**Campus Network Usage Regulations for Graduating Students**  
**during Extended Dormitory Stays**

August 15, 2006 Amended and passed by the 2,444<sup>th</sup> Administrative Meeting

- Article 1 Students of National Taiwan University (“the University”) who are graduating in the current academic year and who wish to extend their stay at a University dormitory after completing their school-leaving procedures may apply for network usage privileges in accordance with the *Campus Network Usage Regulations for Graduating Students during Extended Dormitory Stays* (“the Regulations”).
- Article 2 Graduates of the current year may apply for campus network usage privileges with the Computer and Information Networking Center by presenting a proof of housing and filling out a Campus Network Usage Regulations Acknowledgement Form for Graduates of the Current Year.
- Article 3 The fees for the extended service shall be calculated as follows:
1. Graduates who will be studying in another academic program at the University in the following semester may present their admission letter and apply to have their computer and network fees for the extended stay to be included in the new semester’s fees.
  2. Graduates who are only extending their housing agreements will not be charged additional fees for computer and network usage prior to the conclusion of the semester of their graduation;  
however, during the extension period the computer and network usage fee shall be prorated based on the number of months extended (any partial month shall count as a full month).
- Article 4 The Regulations shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented.
