## **Computer and Information Networking Center Standards for Computer Equipment Usage Fees**

- Article 1 The National Taiwan University (NTU or "the University") Computer and Information Networking Center ("the Center") Standards for Computer Equipment Usage Fees ("the Standards") are set in accordance with Article 6 of the Center's Regulations for the Management of Computer Equipment and Computing Resource Services.
- Article 2 To support teaching and research and to promote the digitization of administrative processes, applicants who seek to use the Center's computer equipment for non-profit-seeking purposes and who meet any of the following conditions may, once approved by the Center, be granted a discount:
  - 1. NTU units may be granted a fee waiver for official course offerings.
  - 2. NTU units may be granted a 50% discount when organizing academic events.
  - 3. NTU clubs may be granted a 75% discount if they are organizing computer training courses targeted at faculty, staff, and students of the University.
- Article 3 The fee standards for computer laboratories are as follows:
  - 1. Classroom 110: NT\$6,600 per session
  - 2. Classroom 116: NT\$10,600 per session
  - 3. Classroom 212: NT\$10,600 per session
  - 4. Classroom 206: NT\$10,600 per session

Fees shall be calculated on a per three-hour session basis. Usage of fewer than 3 hours shall be counted as a full session of 3 hours.

- Article 4 The fee standards for distance learning classrooms are as follows:
  - 1. Venue fee
    - 1) Classroom 106: NT\$14,000 per session
    - 2) Classroom 208: NT\$3,000 per session
  - 2. Videoconferencing equipment and network connection fee:
    - 1) Classroom 106: NT\$6,000 per session

- 2) Classroom 208: NT\$4,000 per session
- 3. Video recording fee: NT\$500 per session

Fees shall be calculated on a per three-hour session basis. Usage of fewer than three hours shall be counted as a full session of three hours.

- Article 5 Additional charges may be incurred under certain circumstances, such as:
  - 1. Fees for employee overtime pay
  - 2. Cost derived from repairing or replacing damaged equipment
- Article 6 The Standards shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
