**Regulations for Student Campus Computing and Internet**  
**Access Fees**

January 16, 2018    Passed by the 2,980<sup>th</sup> Administrative Meeting

- Article 1    National Taiwan University (NTU or “the University”) formulates the NTU *Regulations for Student Campus Computing and Internet Access Fees* (“the Regulations”) to promote the application of information technology and the Internet, promote the digitization of administrative, educational, and student affairs, provide a University-wide network infrastructure and information service for students, improve the overall digital environment for students, and enforce the “user-pays” principle.
- Article 2    Student campus computing and Internet access fees as referred to in the Regulations shall include fees for students’ use of University computers, for the use of the Internet, and for lecture/practicum sessions.
- Article 3    Fees  
Non-boarding students shall pay a semesterly fee of NT\$400 and boarding students a semesterly fee of NT\$600 at the time of registration in each semester.
- Article 4    The Regulations shall be passed by the Administrative Meeting and then implemented on the date of promulgation.
